Starter Pack | Use real objects, not a timer

1. A three-object hunt

Find a red thing, a blue thing and a yellow thing. Draw one, or show it to someone.

2. Count up to five

Put five small objects in a line. Touch one object for each number you say.

one two three four five

3. Let your partner choose

Ask someone to choose a color or a number. Find that color, or show that many fingers. Then swap roles.

An animal conversation

Starter Pack | Words to choose: cat, dog, bird, fish

1. Choose your animal

Draw an animal or point to one in a book.

2. Try a little phrase

It is a _____.

I like _____.

3. Your partner asks

"Is it a cat?" Answer "Yes" or "No". A nod or a point is fine while the words are new.

Answers, adaptations and a small next step

Keep it relaxed

Choose one activity. You can read the instructions aloud, offer two choices or let your child point before speaking. Age suggestions are not an assessment.

Answers / possible responses

Page 1: Open answers. Children may use an invented name and any real preference.

Page 2: The objects match red, blue and yellow. Counting sequence: one, two, three, four, five.

Page 3: Match the phrase to the chosen animal. There is no single correct drawing or preference.

Make it easier or stretch it

Keep two words visible at first. Revisit a familiar page on another day instead of adding more words immediately. Ask for a phrase only when a word feels comfortable.

Pour les parents
